This release comes with fixed issues only.

Fixed Issues

This section lists the Rsam module that contains the fixed issues.

Rsam – 9.2.2223.2

- **GRCPRD-3637** Fixed an issue where, the *Rsam Log Cleanup* task did not delete or archive the log table in batches, which resulted in *transaction log is full* error.
- **GRCPRD-3688** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, the saved search displayed a different owner name, when opened from the Admin module.
- **GRCPRD-3689** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, users were unable to export the Import Mapping when Object Identifiers 1 and 2 were defined.
- **GRCPRD-3696** Fixed an issue with Reporting where, in some scenarios, the report generator did not complete the task when generating a report for a record search through a scheduled task.
- **GRCPRD-3715** Fixed an issue with browser *auto-complete* feature which saved user credentials in Create User and Change Password forms. This fix addresses potential vulnerabilities found during Penetration Testing.
- **GRCPRD-3717** Fixed an issue where users were unable to enter HTML tags for Record-type Tab Names.
- GRCPRD-3804 Fixed an issue with Rapid Reports where, a generated report did not follow the time zone set in User Preferences and instead, displayed the time based on database time zone.
 Note: To enable the fix, you must replace the *.rdl* files on the Report Server with the *.rdl* files (*RSAM_DOCUMENT_1.rdl* and *RSAM_DOCUMENT_SECTION_ATTRIBUTE.rdl*) available in the *RapidReports.zip* of the Rsam 9.2.2223.2 installer.
- **GRCPRD-3813** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, users were unable to export the Import Mapping of an aspect object.
- **GRCPRD-3837** Fixed an issue where, an RA handler action that had an API call executed from the Simulate Workflow Button in the Import page, failed to execute the subsequent handler actions after running the API call.



- **GRCPRD-3865** Fixed an issue where, the Workflow State column filter was not getting loaded if Record Type column did not exist on the grid.
- **GRCPRD-3925** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, synchronization between local and remote instances failed when the control comments contained double quotes (").
- **GRCPRD-3930** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, in a record saved search, the grandchild records were displayed under the root record instead of the child record.
- **GRCPRD-3937** Fixed an issue with Object Import where, only the first row from the file was imported and rest of the rows were skipped, if object attribute was used as unique identifier.

- **RSAM-2180** Fixed a memory leak issue with Rsam API.
- **RSAM-2296** Fixed an issue where, when a user returned to the Assessment Navigator after viewing an assessment and searched for a new assessment, Rsam displayed the previously viewed assessment instead of the search results.
- **RSAM-2292** Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, auto answers appeared in the Assessment Questionnaire but were not selected in the search dropdown. This happened after importing the assessment questions through a CSV file.

Enhancements

This section lists the enhancement in this release.

Option to mandate filter for Record Type

A new option has been introduced in Rsam to mandate a filter for the Record Type fields in all Record searches. When searches are run without filters on instances with huge volume of data, it can cause delays and performance issues. With this option, Rsam Administrators can prevent users from running record searches without record type filters; thereby improving the search performance.

The new option, **Force Record Type filter on Record Search**, is available at *Manage > Administration > Options > Rsam Options > General Web Options*.

For more information on using the feature, refer the *Rsam Help documentation*.

Fixed Issues

This section lists the Rsam modules that contain the fixed issues.

Records – 9.2.2221.2

RSAM-891 Fixed an issue where, in some scenarios, updates made to records did not get saved when users clicked a button configured to run SSRS reports. This was happening only when using the Google Chrome browser.

Rsam – 9.2.2221.2

- **RSAM-282** Fixed an issue where the environment migration XML file generation took longer or sometimes became unresponsive.
- **RSAM-766** Fixed an issue where the size of the Action menu remained fixed, even when length of the button names inside the menu changed.

Synchronize LDAP Groups via Scheduled Task

The scheduled task, **LDAP Account Validation**, has been enhanced to synchronize group description of the LDAP groups and group assignment of the users, based on the changes in the LDAP server.

To achieve this, the following changes have been made:


- Two new options have been added to Rsam Options > LDAP Account Validation, which are as follows:
 - During scheduled "LDAP Account Validation", refresh LDAP group description
 - During scheduled "LDAP Account Validation", refresh user's group assignment for all valid accounts
- The following options in Rsam Options > LDAP Account Validation have been updated to include LDAP groups:
 - During scheduled "LDAP Account Validation", email the list of invalid LDAP users / groups to the following RSAM user account
 - During scheduled "LDAP Account Validation", check existing Rsam user / group accounts and generate an email notification for any invalid accounts
- The User / Group No Longer Exists In LDAP event category in the Notification Events has been updated to include LDAP groups.

API Key Enhancements

The following API key enhancements have been done in this release.

API Key in My Preferences

The API key details will now be available in **My Preferences**. The API key details were previously available only in the Manage Users page, and only those users with access to this page could manage the API key. With this enhancement, Standard Users (who do not have access to Manage Users page) can now generate, view, copy, and delete the API key. The following image shows the new **My Preferences** dialog box. For more information, refer *Rsam Administrator / User Help*.





Group Level API Access

The following enhancement has been made in the Manage Users page. A new hyperlink, **Granted from Group(s)**, has been added to the Manage Users page. Clicking this link will open a dialog box displaying the group names which are providing API access to the user. This is applicable ONLY when a user gets group level API access (i.e. the user is assigned to a group that has API access).

Fixed Issues

Standard users, who have HighBond Admin access, will now have the option *HighBond Platform* in the Saved Search dialog box. With this option, standard users can enable Rsam Searches to be available for use in the HighBond platform.

Password Reset Link

When a user clicks the *Forgot Password* link and provides a valid User ID, Rsam sends a Password Reset Link to the registered email address of the user. On clicking the Password Reset Link, it opens a Change Password page where user must verify the Rsam User ID and set a new password. Each link is unique to the user requesting the password reset. This security improvement ensures that only rightful users can reset account passwords.



In the coming weeks (mid-May), existing Rsam cloud customers will be able to get access to a cloud instance of the HighBond platform <u>(and on-premise Rsam customers will get the similar capabilities in the future)</u>. This version of Rsam includes some initial integration with *HighBond*, allowing cloud customers to perform the following:

- 1. Build HighBond Executive Storyboards based on Rsam Search result data.
- 2. Allow users to navigate from Rsam to HighBond without having to reauthenticate.
- 3. Access HighBond Robotics for data analytics and automation.



Customers can opt to have the HighBond integration deployed by contacting the *Rsam Customer Support Team*. For more information on accessing HighBond from Rsam, refer the *Rsam Administrator Help* and the *Rsam Integration with HighBond Guide*.

Support for SharePoint Online

Rsam now allows you to connect to the SharePoint Online site, which is a cloud-hosted service. This is in addition to the on-premise SharePoint support and provides the ability to write a file stored by a file attachment attribute in Rsam to a SharePoint site. The Rsam and SharePoint integration is beneficial for several use cases, and by leveraging the SharePoint Online support within Rsam, users do not have to switch between Rsam and SharePoint to post documents.

A pre-requisite would be to have SharePoint login credentials to access the site.

Rsam Import has been enhanced to allow customers to specify when to run post processing actions on the imported files. Running these actions once after all files are imported significantly improves the import performance as opposed to running the actions after importing each file, in the import bundle, into the system.

This is accomplished by the new **Run Post Processing actions after all files are imported** check box in the Import pages and available for all file-based imports.

Rsam provides a default task, handler actions, and connectors to set up the Data Synchronization feature.

Define Scope for Unmatched Items using Saved Search

In the Import Actions screen, Rsam now allows customers to specify a scope to limit the <u>Unmatched</u> Objects / Records that are to be processed (Change Workflow State or Simulate Workflow Button) after import. This enhancement greatly improves the import performance when using the Unmatched actions as the number of Objects / Records to be processed after import gets reduced based on the scope defined.

This is accomplished by creating a search which contains all record / objects that are in scope for the import, selecting the option for *Custom Reports* / *Metrics* / *Filter, and saving it.* Then, in the import **Action** tab, you can select this search to narrow the scope of unmatched records / objects.
